



# The Next 70 Years

In celebrating our 70th Anniversary this year I have written a lot about the past. It seems like just yesterday when we were unloading box cars of lumber and sweeping

up mounds of sawdust from the big planer in our old mill - it seems almost unbelievable from that small lumber yard on Main Street with eleven employees has now grown to over 180 employees in five states.

I anticipate a very bright future for our family business over the next 70 years. Most of this anticipated growth will come from the distribution of our three core products in the five states. These products are Aristokraft Cabinets, Engineered Lumber and Therma

Tru Entrance Doors. Being in Vincennes we are strategically located just three to four hours from four major metro markets: Indianapolis, St. Louis, Louisville and Nashville, Tennessee. These

major markets will give us unlimited growth for the future.

Besides distributing to our traditional independent dealers, we have been asked to distribute these products to some of the national and regional chains in this five state market. Home Depot Expo's in St. Louis and Nashville, eleven Lowes stores in this area and several 84 Lumber's and Carter Lumber's are some of these chain stores we will be selling.

Another new Niehaus Company, Karran U.S.A., also has a bright future for our family business. Karran is the name of a line of sinks made of solid acrylic material similar to Corian. Niehaus Companies became the national importer a little over 2 years ago and is promoting the line nation wide. Several large distributors have been set up across the country. Sales were up 50% last year, and for the first four months of this year, up 72%.

I am really looking forward to the next several years watching the family business grow. It has been very rewarding to work with my three sons and see the enthusiasm and energy I had 40 years ago.






